400+ units	<p>ELEVATOR: We do not have them but have explored them for an elevator modernization and the system that was most recommended was Captive</p> <p>LOBBY DISPLAY We use Building Link and have explored what it would take to make a Public Display for our lobbies (we have not installed the displays--only researched). 400+ units	<p>Our Board has discussed this in the past but felt that it would be visually out of place. Several Board members worried that it would look like a hotel. Others had concerns about increasing energy usage, no matter how slight.</p>
